The Hydrogen Peroxide Absorption/Desorption of Ultra Corrosion Nickel Plated (color: silver) was investigated with the stated test parameters. Using the procedure laid down in VDI 2083 Part 20, the following test result was obtained:

Ø k-value [min]	Standard deviation [min]	Classification
-0.3	0.0	non-absorptive

The k-value represents the required decay time to reduce the hydrogen peroxide vapor concentration measured at the beginning of the aeration phase to one tenth of the original concentration. The material classification is based on three separate measurements. The blank value of the test setup is subtracted from each measurement value.
