The luminaire series TBH is suitable for use in cleanrooms fulfilling the Air Cleanliness Class 2.

A principle recommendation can be made for use in hygienic areas up to a maximum of GMP Cleanliness Class C. However, this only applies for the assessed operating utility in a resting state and the luminaire series TBH would need to be reassessed after assembly in a manufacturing environ-

In the case where no national standards exist, the measuring procedure used corresponds with technical regulations and norms valid at the time of the measurement.
